

TORQUE CHART

Tighten all screws, bolts, and nuts to their specified torque values. Refer to the Service Manual for the torque values of the removed parts.

6 mm bolt	10	1.0	7


USE AND CARE INFORMATION

 Check the accessory mounts frequently and retighten if necessary.


INSTALLATION


CAUTION:

- To prevent burns, allow the engine, exhaust system, etc., to cool before installing the accessory.
- 1. Refer to the Service Manual for the motorcycle, remove the Rear wheel.
 - Support the motorcycle securely and raise the rear wheel off the ground using a center stand (sold separately) or hoist.



2. Remove the bolt and clips as shown.







3. Clean the surface of the area shown using isopropyl alcohol.




4. Place the hugger as shown.




5. Mark the swingarm as shown in the figure.




- 6. Remove the hugger and attach the protection tape to the swingarm according to the dimensions shown.
 - Attach the tape centered between the left and right hole.



7. Install the collar as shown.



8. Install the hugger as shown.



9. Install the rear wheel in the reverse order of removal.
