



▲ CAUTION


 To prevent burns, allow the engine, exhaust system, radiator, etc., to cool before installing the accessory.

NOTE:


- Take care not to damage the painted surfaces of the motorcycle.
- Reinstall the removed parts on the motorcycle and make sure that wires and harnesses are not pinched.
- Disconnect the negative (-) cable from the battery before installing this accessory.
- The memory of the clock will be erased when you disconnect the battery. Reset the clock after reconnecting the battery.
- Trim the excess ends off the wire ties after attaching them to the wire harnesses. Do not allow the cut part of the wire tie to interfere with any harness or brake hose.
- When replacing the sub harness, that is required to install this accessory, follow the instructions described in these installation instructions.
- Illustrations show CTX700N type, other type is similar.

INSTALLATION (CTX700N/ND)


1. Refer to the Service Manual for the motorcycle, remove the seat, and disconnect the negative (-) cable from the battery as shown.




2. Refer to the Service Manual for the motorcycle, remove the right rear cowl.




3. Refer to the Service Manual for the motorcycle, remove the right radiator cover.




4. Refer to the Service Manual for the motorcycle, remove the right shelter.




5. Refer to the Service Manual for the motorcycle, open the shelter lid and pocket lid as shown.




- 6. Drill a 30 mm hole at the marked point on the side of the pocket using an electric drill and hole saw.
 - Remove any burrs from the edge of the hole.









Remove the dummy connector 6P connector as shown.




9. Connect the sub harness as shown.




10. Install the 6-pin waterproof connector as shown.





















INSTALLATION (CTX700/D)


1. Refer to the Service Manual for the motorcycle, remove the seat, and disconnect the negative (-) cable from the battery as shown.




2. Refer to the Service Manual for the motorcycle, remove the right rear grip.




3. Refer to the Service Manual for the motorcycle, remove the right rear cowl.




4. Refer to the Service Manual for the motorcycle, remove the inner covers.




5. Refer to the Service Manual for the motorcycle, remove the windscreen moulding.




6. Refer to the Service Manual for the motorcycle, remove the side cowls.




7. Refer to the Service Manual for the motorcycle, remove the right shelter.




8. Refer to the Service Manual for the motorcycle, open the shelter lid and pocket lid as shown.




- 9. Drill a 30 mm hole at the marked point on the side of the pocket using an electric drill and hole saw.



































