

TORQUE CHART


Tighten all screws, bolts, and nuts to their specified torque values. Refer to the Service Manual for the torque values of the removed parts.


INSTALLATION

CAUTION:


- To prevent burns, allow the engine, exhaust system, radiator, etc. to cool before installing the accessory.
- 1. Remove the right footpeg bar as shown.




- Repeat on the left side.
- Assemble the band with the stay as shown.




4. Loosely install the assembled bands as shown.




5. Loosely install the engine guard.




6. Attach tape to the frame downtubes in the positions shown.




7. Mark the frame downtubes at the top of the bands as shown.




8. Cut the rubber to the dimension shown.



9. Remove the engine guard and assembled bands, and attach the rubbers in the positions shown.





RUBBER Clean the attachment surface thoroughly and attach after removing the adhesive backing.

- 10. Remove the tapes, and loosely install the assembled bands and engine guard.
- 11. Tighten all mounting to the specification in the torque table after adjusting the overall fit of the accessory.
