



TORQUE CHART

Tighten all screws, bolts, and nuts to their specified torque values. Refer to the Service Manual for the torque values of the removed parts.




NOTE:


- The Rear carrier attachment is required for installation of this accessory.
- Heat the bonding surfaces with a hair dryer if the ambient air temperature is below 70°F (21°C).
- The adhesive reaches full strength in 72 hours. Wait at least 24 hours before riding your motorcycle.
- 1. Clean the surface of the area shown using isopropyl alcohol.

<Rear side>




2. Attach the safety label in the position shown.







3. Remove the passenger seat as shown.



4. Remove the caps from the right grab rail as shown.





- 5. Loosely install the right rear carrier bar as shown.
 - Protect the rear fender with a shop towel or similar.



6. Repeat Steps 4 and 5 on the left side.

7. Loosely install the rear carrier as shown.





- 8. Tighten the loosely installed parts securely.
- 9. Install the passenger seat in the reverse order of removal.
 - Protect with a shop towel or similar, and take care not to tear the passenger seat.
